The Association has at present 93 sustaining member companies and 295 individual members.

Supply Companies are assessed a fee of \$225.00 for an annual membership and also \$30.00 for each individual member that wishes to join. Supply members are assessed \$30.00 for dinner and refreshments for each individual attending a meeting.

Railroad Companies are assessed a fee of \$200.00 for annual membership and also \$30.00 for each individual member that wishes to join. Railroad members are not assessed an additional fee for dinner and refreshments.

Retired railroad and supply members are assessed a fee of \$15.00 for annual membership and \$15.00 monthly dinner fee for each meeting attended. Retired railroaders and suppliers will not be charged a monthly fee the first season after they retire.
